Unbridled Response Fund

Purpose and Class:

The purpose of the Unbridled Response Fund is to provide aid to victims of natural disasters or personal hardships. Contributions are tax deductible and will be matched through the UnbridledACTS general fund.

Types of qualified disasters and hardships:

- A. Qualified Disasters
 - a. Results from terrorist or military actions
 - b. Results from an accident involving a common carrier
 - c. Is a Presidentially-declared disaster
 - d. Is deemed catastrophic by the Secretary of the Treasury
- B. Personal Hardship
 - a. Serious illness or injury
 - b. Undue hardship not caused by employee
 - c. Fire, flood, or natural disaster
 - d. Military deployment
 - e. Violent crime
 - f. Death of employee or eligible dependent

Selection:

UnbridledACTS will have an independent selection committee that determines grant recipients based on an objective determination of need. Individuals do not have to be totally destitute to be financially needy—they may merely lack the resources to obtain basic necessities. Funds cannot be distributed to individuals merely because they are victims of a disaster.
